

Patient Transport Volunteer



Pendleside Hospice is one of the principal providers of palliative and end of life care services to adults in Burnley and Pendle and is held in deep affection by the local community. All our care is free of charge to our patients and their families and carers but, of course, it isn't free to provide and most of it is funded through the generosity of the local community in which we serve. In the current year, it will cost over £5.5 million to run Pendleside Hospice, of which over £4.7 million will need to be raised through voluntary donations.

THE ROLE OF A PATIENT TRANSPORT VOLUNTEER

Supporting our Health, Wellbeing & Rehabilitation team, you will collect customers who require transport to the hospice and back home again. You would be required to use your own car and mileage expenses will be reimbursed. We also have a hospice minibus for which training can be given. The session times are from 10am until 12pm and 1.30pm until 3.30pm each day. You could commit to a morning, afternoon or both, it is entirely up to you. Any time you can give is greatly appreciated.
